

# Winter Clothes List

To ensure your child gets the most out of their day please can you provide the following items during the colder/ winter months. We ask parents to put children in their clothes as we don't get messy in the garden and we don't want to ruin the children's good clothes. At North 5 Nidj / we don't get whatever the weather/including the babies.



Wear boots so we can go splash in puddles.



Always wear a raincoat. This will ensure the children can go outside whatever the weather.



Wear something like a thick jumper/sweater etc. This is to ensure we don't get cold.



A hat/gloves and scarf for the colder weather.



Please can you ensure all items are packed and you are well prepared to leave them at nursery in a bag/basket to help.



A water bottle so we can stay hydrated at all times/including when we are out and about in the garden. This allows the children to have refreshment whenever they are drinking.

# Summer Clothes List

To ensure your child gets the most out of their day please can you provide the following items during the warmer/dryer months. We ask parents to put children in clothes as we don't get messy in the garden and we don't want to ruin the children's good clothes. At Qurtz 5 Nid/ we don't get whatever the weather and we want to protect the children from harmful UV rays.



Please can you provide sun cream for your child during the Summer months (April-September). This is to ensure children don't get burnt whilst in your care. We ask parents to provide sun cream as some children have allergies to certain sun creams.



A water bottle so we can stay hydrated at all times/ especially when we are out and about in warm and sunny weather. This allows the children to take refreshment if they are thirsty.



A sun hat



Spare clothes e.g. shirts/ t-shirt or vest tops. As we don't use the paddling pool and have water fights during the Summer months.



Alternatively if you are very worried to supply a sun suit or swimwear outfit during the warmer months/ we supply swim caps for those who are still in nappies.



Please can you ensure all items are packed and spare clothes in a bag which you are very worried to need at nursery.
